

GETTING TO ERICEIRA FROM LISBON

There will be two buses leaving from the airport, dully identified with the NA Erasmus+ sign: at 16:00 and at 20:00.

Ana Alves (+351 962 776 830) will be waiting for you at 16:00.

Ana Barroso (+351 962 439 368) will be there at 20:00 making sure no one stays back.

The buses will leave from the street in front of the underground station.



If you arrive long before the departure of the buses, you can go to the city centre by metro. Please be sure to come back in time to catch our bus to Ericeira (it takes about I hour to get from the city centre (Rossio/Baixa-Chiado) to the airport.
